

Safety Briefing Northern Beaches Boating Pty Ltd

Welcome to The Northern Beaches Boating Pre-Departure Safety Briefing, an essential companion to our Terms and Conditions and Risk Waiver.

Prior to your journey, we kindly request that you review this document. By selecting the checkbox when submitting a reservation with Northern Beaches Boating, you are confirming your acknowledgment, agreement and understanding of the safety instructions provided below.

Your safety is our top priority, and we appreciate your cooperation in ensuring a secure and enjoyable voyage.

- 1. In the event of an emergency, please pay close attention to the Crew and / or Captain's instructions.
 - The emergency action plan is laminated and, on a keyring, next to the console. We will point this out to you when you embark the Vessel.
 - The Radio emergency call instructions are located on a sticker on the console. We will point this out to you when you embark the Vessel.
 - Phone numbers and addresses of the closest hospitals, police station and maritime rescue are laminated on the keyring next to the console. We will point this out to you when you embark the Vessel.
- 2. Life jackets and Buoyancy Aids are stored under the back seats of the boat.
- 3. The first aid kit is located under the Captains seat and is clearly labelled with a sticker
- 4. There are two paddles on the boat which are stored under the back seat of the boat
- 5. Standing up and Moving around in the boat is not permitted whilst the boat is moving and the engine is switched on
- 6. Toilets are only available when leaving and returning to the dock.
- 7. Swimming is only permitted if you are a competent and capable swimmer and are comfortable with the water conditions. Swimming and entry into the water is only permitted once the vessel is anchored with the engine switched off.
- 8. If you are not a competent and capable swimmer unfortunately, you will have to remain in the boat whilst on your trip
- 9. If you have any dietary requirements, allergies or food intolerances, please triple check before consuming any food on the boat. It is your responsibility to handle food which you bring onto the boat or are provided with on the grazing board if you have a known allergy or intolerance



- 10. Please make sure you are physically capable of moving around the boat and if you have any particular condition have been provided with your own medical advice confirming that you are able to participate in the charter. It is your responsibility to ensure that you are physically capable of moving around on the boat, embarking and alighting on and off the Vessel.
- 11. As this is a small boat and we need to keep the floors clear of items to allow us to move around the vessel.
- 12. As there is limited space we recommend that you only bring food, water, Hat and suncream with you. Towels will be provided on the day and you will also receive a small drybag for your phone storage.
- 13. Slip, slop slap. If the sun's out, and even if its not, sunscreen up to protect your skin.
- 14. If you see or smell smoke, please inform the crew immediately.
- 15. Keep a lookout for your mates and any personal objects you bring with you on the boat.
- 16. If you encounter any issues, don't hesitate to approach our Crew or Captain for assistance.
